PHA ADVICE ON RESPIRATORY ILLNESS

Before the Christmas Holidays we seen a huge increase in Flu and other respiratory illnesses. This is quite common during this particular time of the year and is likely to continue to increase in coming weeks.

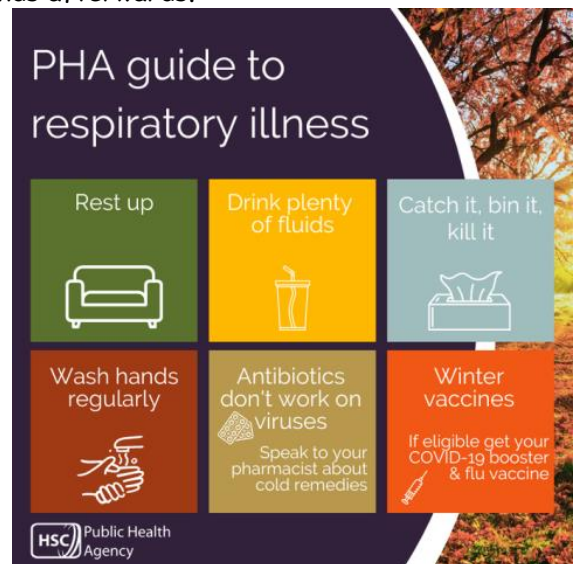
With this in mind the Public Health Agency (PHA) is offering some simple advice to get us through winter and reminding everyone that hand hygiene and self-care are essential when preventing and managing winter illnesses.

The PHA is urging all people eligible for the free flu and COVID-19 vaccines, who have not yet been vaccinated, to get it now and is particularly calling on the parents of pre-school and school-aged children to get them vaccinated against flu.

Evidence shows that the flu vaccine for children can provide direct protection to them and will also reduce the amount of flu circulating, thus providing indirect protection for older people and individuals with underlying health conditions.

Following some simple steps can help protect children, minimise the spread of illness in education and childcare settings and protect wider communities. If your child is unwell and has a fever, they should stay home from school or nursery until they feel better and the fever has resolved.

Good hand and respiratory hygiene is also key, so practice regular handwashing with soap and warm water. Catching coughs and sneezes in tissues then binning them is another simple way to help stop illness from spreading and make sure to wash your hands afterwards."



DO I NEED TO KEEP MY CHILD OFF SCHOOL?

We have had a number of phone calls and enquiries about pupil's sickness and whether a child should be attending school with a suspected illness. The chart below has been issued by PHA regarding some common illnesses that pupils may experience, particularly at this time of the year.

MATHLETICS

Well done to all our P3-P7 children, their teachers, assistants and families who continue to use Mathletics in school and at home to help develop Numeracy and Maths skills. We are so pleased to announce that as a school, the children have achieved 156 Bronze Mathletics certificates, 42 Silver Mathletics certificates and 10 Gold Mathletics certificates to date. Leo, Jack, Aidan and Cliodhna in P4 as well as Conall in P3 were the first students to achieve their Gold certificates this year! The school also achieved 383,900 Curriculum Points and 27,641 Live Mathletics Points. For the first time ever, 'Out of School/Homework Hours on Mathletics' has exceeded 'In School Hours on Mathletics' which is testimony to the wonderful uptake in so many homes.

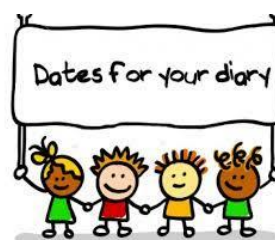
