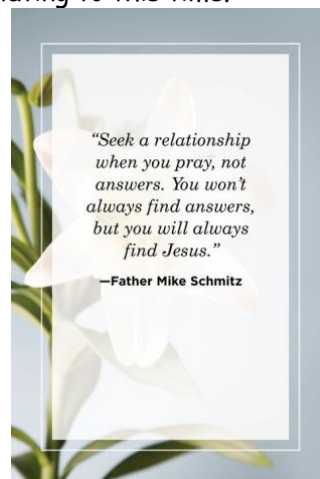


CHILD PROTECTION AND SAFE-GUARDING
